The primer is different.

3. What are some different textures that can be installed in the Standard version? Knock down texture and orange peel texture.

Skip trowel and broom finish.

4. What are different patterns that can be installed in the Custom version? Tile pattern using grout tape and faux flagstone using Stone Strips.

Plaid and checkerboard.

5. How does coloring change between the standard and custom finishes? Using a pigment topcoat versus decorative water-based stains.

Coloring options are the same for both systems.

6. What tool gives Texture-Crete Broom-On its finish?

A notch trowel

A push broom

7. How should the Broom-on material be mixed before application?

Thoroughly with a low rpm drill motor.

Mix for 30 seconds and stop.

8. How is a Wood Finish pattern achieved?

Grout tape for pattern, a broom for texture and Water-Based Stains for color.

Use wood planks and stamp the pattern onto the wet cement material.

9. What is the coloring technique for the Wood Finish stain?

Use a sprayer and broom to apply and set the water-based stain.

Roll and backroll the water-based stain.

10. How often should Texture-Crete be inspected for wear?

Every 2 to 4 years.
